Two Minutes Two Slides: On popular demand we have included "2 minutes 2" slides to drive home practice points that are evidence based. In these punch presentations by young consultants, several "routine" practices are brought forward, and their relevance according to studies will be flashed.

CTG Workshop: CTG for the obstetrician is like ECG for the physicians. While the trace can be taken by any trained person, the interpretation of the trace is to be done very carefully, by the obstetrician, with proper clinical correlation. Most fatal errors arise from improper interpretation, as revealed by confidential inquiries. This workshop will enhance your understanding of fetal physiology and strengthen your skills in interpretation.

Drills: Obstetric emergencies demand quick thinking and correct methods and measures to save life. An entire day is devoted to providing hands-on training in dealing with such situations. Hands on training in the management of difficult deliveries, resuscitation of the mother, prepare you to handle any situation with confidence. Gynaec drills are designed to make you confident in handling gynecological situations, be it quantification of genital organ prolapse or insertion of an IUCD. We have a station to teach you the skills of peeling the cyst wall at laparoscopy or placing sutures. Yet another station to interest you in Hysteroscopy. At the end of the day, the drills will make you feel exhilarated at the skills gained.

Ultrasound Workshop: This workshop is intended to impart focused training in identifying Doppler changes in Fetal growth restriction in obstetrics and how to evaluate adnexal masses by IOTA classification in gynaec usg.

Case Discussions: 4 students from assigned institutions will participate in each case. Case discussions will follow the pattern seen in examinations.

New Drills: Management of Eclamptic mother, the correct way of giving Mgso4, monitoring of the patient and use of antihypertensive drugs. VIVA is integral to your understanding of the practical aspects. Learn to face the VIVA with confidence. This station gives you exposure to specimens, instruments, Partographs, Ultrasound, X-ray etc.

Colposcopy: Cervical cancer mortality rates are outnumbering our maternal mortality rates. We have introduced a lecture on Colposcopy to have a basic knowledge of the procedure and learn about normal and abnormal findings. It is important to diagnose and treat cervical cancer in its early stage to bring down the mortality rates.
