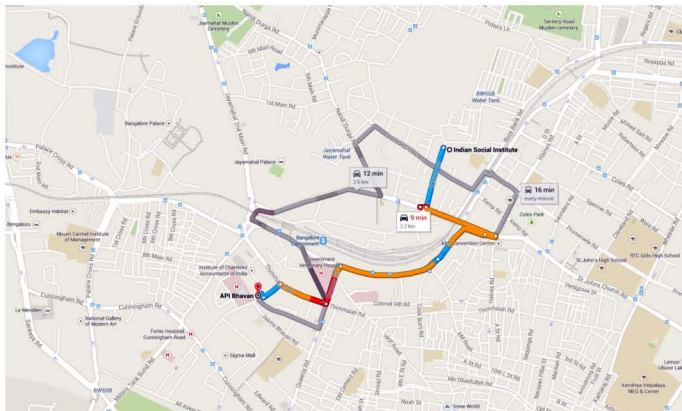


ACCOMMODATION



Please Note: Accommodation (exclusive of transport) has been arranged at Indian Social Institute, No. 24, Benson Road, Bangalore 560 040 Ph: 080-23536189/23536364/23536960. This is the most reasonable accommodation available in Bangalore city with clean rooms and clean toilets. Check in time is 5am. Those who arrive early (on 20th or before 5am on 21st will need to book for another day. Delegates wanting accommodation for their spouses as well need to make their own arrangement. Distance from venue is about 1.5km. Back to Basics: A new introduction to this year's CME, these talks give a firm foundation to clinical knowledge. Students are given a thorough understanding of the pathological features of clinical conditions and clinical management in tricky situations

CTG workshop: CTG for the obstetrician is like ECG for the physicians. While the trace can be taken by any trained person, the interpretation of the trace is to be done very carefully, by the obstetrician, with proper clinical correlation. Most fatal errors arise from improper interpretation, as revealed by confidential inquiries. This workshop will enhance your understanding of fetal physiology and strengthen your skills in interpretation.

Drills: Obstetric emergencies demand quick thinking and correct methods and measures to save life. An entire day is devoted to providing hands-on training in dealing with such situations. Hands on training in the management of difficult deliveries, resuscitation of mother and newborn prepare you to handle any situation with confidence.

Gynaec drills are designed to make you confident in handling gynecological situations, be it quantification of genital organ prolapse or insertion of an IUCD. We have another station to make you adept at using appropriate sutures and appropriate knots in surgeries, one more to teach you the skills of peeling the cyst wall at laparoscopy or placing sutures. Yet another station to interest you in Hysteroscopy. At the end of the day, the drills will make you feel exhilarated at the skills gained.

Ultrasound workshop: Again, basic knowledge of ultrasound is important for sound obstetric practice. This workshop is intended to impart focused training in identifying important fetal structures, markers of aneuploidy, and other features of fetal well-being and ill health.

Table Viva: Histopathology / X ray films / MRI reports / Specimens / Instruments / Drugs / Contraceptives, etc. will be displayed / projected on screen. Candidates will be expected to identify the same and answer questions on it. The session is intended to train students to answer.

Case Discussions: 3 students from assigned institutions will present the case. Case discussions will follow the pattern seen in examinations.

New Drills: As much as it is important to learn assisted vaginal breech delivery, it would be good to learn interventions such as ECV, IPV and Breech extraction: skills that are mandatory to deliver fetuses presenting by breech / shoulder. ECV is a simple and effective maneuver in converting breech to cephalic and facilitating a safer vaginal delivery, thereby reducing the incidence of cesarean section for breech presentation. IPV followed by breech extraction is also an emergency procedure that can help delivery of a foetus in transverse lie. Whether it is a second of twin or a difficult mobile head at Cesarean section, Breech extraction is a skill that one needs to master.

Colposcopy: Cervical cancer mortality rates are outnumbering our maternal mortality rates. A basic knowledge of Colposcopy is a must in identifying Cervical cancer in its early stages and the only means as of now to reduce the mortality. We have introduced this as a hands-on drill station to let you have the experience of looking at the cervix from close quarters.

SDPP Student Delegate Participation Programme
